About The Knight Ryders Club

What started as a breakfast ride between a few like minded bike enthusiasts, has grown to be established as 'The Knight Ryders' (TKR)/ the "Club" in October 2021 as an exclusive motor bike club for owners of Honda CB350 / Honda CB350RS with a moto of 'Ride till the last mile'. In the last 18 months, the Club has grown from a few members to one of the largest exclusive Honda CB 350/RS Club with **29 members, 98 riders and 190+ registered riders**

The Club organises short / long rides on regular basis where interested people participate after registering through the Club's website

The Club had conducted so far 48 rides (15 overnight trips and 33 day trips) covering 4 southern states of TN, Kerala, Karnataka, AP and two UTs Goa and Pudhucherry covering a total distance of 23,648kms.

Updates for the quarter

During the quarter, the Club conducted 2 over night rides and 4 short rides. The most anticipated ride to Goa in January covering 2000+kms with 13 riders over 6 days was a feather in the cap of the Club. Also, towards end of February, we drove to Wayanad where the riders trekked in Chembra Hills (considered to be one of the toughest in Kerala) which was a unique experience. Two riders (Chandru and Naveen) were included as members during this period.

CSR activity

In line with the key objective of giving back to community, during the period, the Club donated **Rs.20,000** to 'All the Children', a social improvement organisation assisting children and elderly people. The amount was paid towards education sponsorship of a needy child. We expect more such activities and contributions in the future.

Other matters

The Club felicitated, Mr. Venu, RM, at KUN BigWing on his career change. **Mr. Venu** had been very supportive of the Club's activities and rides. We wish him a successful career.

Looking forward The Club is inching towards two important milestones (50th ride and 25,000kms of riding together) which we can expect to happen anytime soon.

Overnight rides (Jan - Mar 2023)

Goa (25 Jan - 30 Jan)

Total distance – 2050kms, Riders-13

One of the epic ride by the Club so far. The riders passed through 3 states (Tamil Nadu, Karnataka and Maharashtra) and reaching Goa (Union Territory) covering over 2000+kms spreading from East Coast to West Coast. The drive through western ghats to reach Jog Falls was a quite a mesmerizing experience. The ride further to Goa with the mountain on the one side and beach on the other side was another level of experience. The riders had quite a relaxing time in Goa exploring the local attractions, beaches and the food.

Wayanad (25 Feb - 28 Feb)

Total distance – 1500kms, Riders-22

A 4 day ride to Kerala, God's own country with 22 riders exploring the nature and the local cultural and heritage sites. The ride covered 3 southern states (TN, Karnataka and Kerala) and through 2 tiger reserve forests (Satyamangalam and Bandhipur). Riding through the tiger reserve forests was an additional thrill to the trip. Off-roading through Kurumabalakotta to view the sunset would be in our memories for a long time. The trek in Chembra Hills, considered to be one of the most difficult in Kerala, tested the endurance and stamina of most. The beautiful view from the top made us forget the pain we had to endure during the trek.

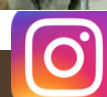
