About The Knight Ryders Club

What started as a breakfast ride between a few like minded bike enthusiasts, has grown to be established as 'The Knight Ryders' (TKR)/ the "Club" in October 2021 as an exclusive motor bike club for owners of Honda CB350 / Honda CB350RS with a moto of 'Ride till the last mile'. In the last one year, the Club has grown from a few members to one of the largest exclusive Honda CB 350/RS Club with 32 members, 94 riders and 190+ registered users.

The Club organises short / long rides on regular basis where interested people participate after registering

through the Club's website www.theknightryders.com

The Club had conducted so far 42 rides covering 4 southern states of TN, Kerala, Karnataka and AP and Pudhucherry UT (12 overnight and 30 day) over a period of 18 months covering a total distance of 19,227kms. The Club's utmost priority is to ensure safety of the riders and other road users. The riders are required to appropriate safety gears (full face helmet, riding jacket, riding pants, gloves and riding boots), follow the riding discipline and the safety guidance's provided by the Club's members.

The Club members has also taken pledge not to horn unnecessarily, not to litter the environment during the group bike rides and leave the environment undisturbed. Being responsible citizens, the Club members actively take part in various CSR activities.

In the recent past, the Club celebrated the 75th Independence day with children and senior citizens from a orphanage and old age home. The Club also pledged to financially support some of the infrastructure work to be carried at the orphanage and old age home.

Overnight Rides (Oct - Dec 2022)

Yercaud (15-16 Oct 2022)

Total distance – 760kms, Riders-20

A special 2 day ride was organised to celebrate the 1 st anniversary of The Knight Ryders Club

Gandikota (29-31 Oct 2022)

Total distance – 812kms, Riders-22

Gandikota is a small village on the banks of Penna river in Kadappa district in Andhra Pradesh. It is also known as the 'Great Canyon of India'.

Valparai (2 - 4 Dec 2022)

Total distance – 1,270kms, Riders-18

Travelling between Pollachi to Valparai is itself an exotic experience. (source: Coimbatore.nic.in). Valparai is also close to Kerala border and the famous Athirappilly Water Falls is approx. 80kms from Valparai.

Kanyakumari (28 - 30 Dec 2022)

Total distance – 1520kms, Riders-13

By far this is one the longest one way ride by TKR group. Kanyakumari is the southern tip of India situated nearly 700kms from Chennai. Kanyakumari is the only place in the world where sunrise and sunset can be witnessed over the ocean.

Short / Day Rides (Oct - Dec 2022)

Kanchangiri fort (2 Oct 2022)

Total distance – 255kms, Riders-17

This ride was organized in collaboration with Honda BigWing South (KUN). Kanchangiri is situated at 1500 feet above sea level near Vellore and houses a small Shiva temple and Murugan temple

Mudaliyarkuppam (13 Nov 2022)

Total distance – 180kms, Riders-15

This ride was organized as a breakfast ride to Mudaliyarkuppam on a rainy day to show that weather doesn't deter TKR riders to go on a trip.

National Fossil Wood Park, Tiruvakkarai (20 Nov 2022)

Total distance – 254kms, Riders-29

The park contains petrified wood fossils approximately 20 million years old and spread over 247 acres.

Fort ride, Gingee (4 Nov 2022)

Total distance – 280kms, Riders-12

This fort was ranked by Maratha ruler Shivaji Maharaj as the 'most impregnable fortress in India' and also called as 'Troy of East' by British.

French Castle Ride, Arni (24 Dec 2022)

Total distance – 265kms, Riders-18

This fort was ranked by Maratha ruler Shivaji Maharaj as the 'most impregnable fortress in India' and also called as 'Troy of East' by British.
