About The Knight Ryders Club

What started as a breakfast ride between a few like minded bike enthusiasts, has grown to be established as 'The Knight Ryders' (TKR)/ the 'Club' in October 2021 as an exclusive motor bike club for owners of Honda CB350 / Honda CB350RS with the moto 'RIDE TILL THE LAST MILE'. In the last 21 months, the Club has grown from a few members to one of the largest exclusive Honda CB 350 Club with **29 members, 129 riders and 275+ registered users.**

The Club organises short / long rides on regular basis where interested people participate after registering through the Club's website.

The Club had conducted so far 55 rides (18 overnight trips and 37 day trips) covering 4 southern states of TN, Kerala, Karnataka, AP and two UTs Goa and Pudhucherry covering a total distance of 27,000+ kms and cumulative distance of 500,000+ kms.

Updates for the quarter

In this period, the Club conducted 3 overnight rides and 3 day trips. This quarter saw the Club achieving two mile stones 1) 50th ride and 2) 25,000 kms which is a feather in the Club's activities. Further, the riders count soared to 129 during this quarter which is a fantastic achievement. Along with HondaBigWing, Chennai the Club conducted a ride to Kolli Hills in June 2023 which had max participation of 69 riders.

Two members achieved unique distinction during this quarter. Santosh Krishnan completed **20,000 kms** (max kms) and Jiju Pushkaran participated in **41 rides** (max rides) so far. This surely motivates people to '**RIDE TILL THE LAST MILE**'.

CSR activity

Giving back to the community is one of the key objective and commitment of the Club. During the quarter, the Club had contributed to SankalpTaru, an organisation which is supporting tree planting activities across India. The Club contributed towards their projects which is an initiative to lend a helping hand to farmers by planting fruit bearing trees like Sapota, Pomegranate, Guava, Coconut etc. on their lands, strengthening the options of livelihoods while also enriching greenery in the region. So far **55 trees** had been planted by the Club.

Overnight rides (Apr - Jun 2023)

Kodaikanal (7Apr - 9Apr)

Total distance – 1070kms, Riders-17

A ride to Kodaikanal, the princess of hill stations during summer brought much relief to the riders who were waiting for a long ride since the last trip to Wayanad in February 2023. The riders visited Kookal falls and the 'world famous omelette' shop in Poombarai.

Kotagiri (19May - 21May)

Total distance – 1100kms, Riders-20

The scorching summer in Chennai was becoming unbearable. The needed break came in the form of 3 days ride to Kotagiri with 20 riders. The riders enjoyed the pleasant weather of Kotagiri and also visited the famous 'Kodanad view point' and 'Catherine falls'.

Kolli Hills (17Jun - 18 Jun)

Total distance – 747kms, Riders-69

HondaBigWing Chennai, sponsored a ride to Kolli Hills (famously known as Mountains of Death) with huge participation of riders. The ride was sponsored by HondaBigWing, Chennai and conducted by the Club. It was a challenging and thrilling experience to ride through the 70+ hair pin bends of Kolli Hills with 69 rides. The riders also visited the famous Aagaya Gangai falls.

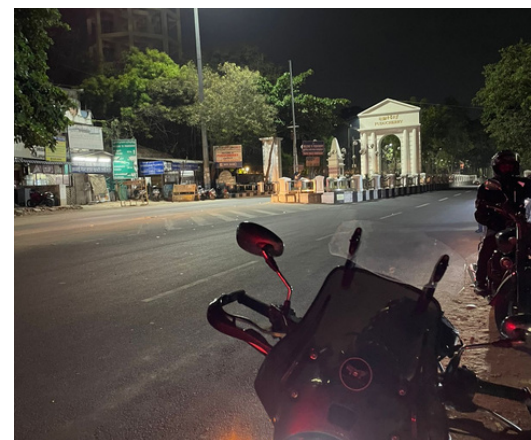
